Louise Ward MIACP

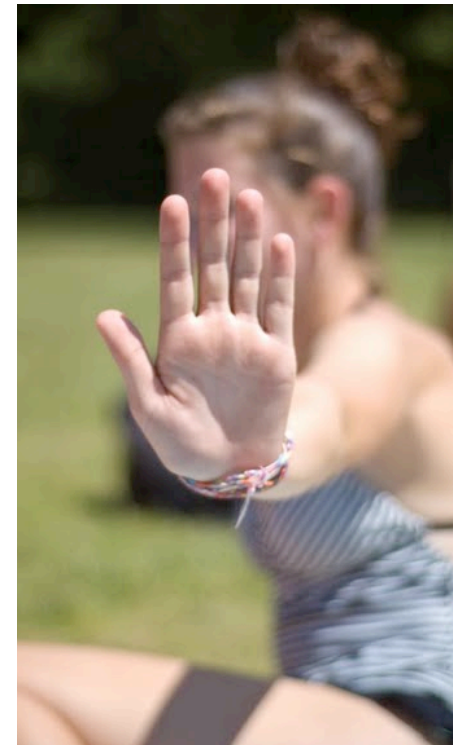
